Forest management contract



Many forestry associations offer so called "forest management contracts". Together with the forester of the regarding forestry association forest owners can regularly plan the necessary silvicultural actions.

This is an interesting approach especially for old forest owners who can't any more take care. Furthermore it is an opportunity also for the new forest owner generation with high percentage living far away from the estate.

The state forester is looking after all actions after the forest owner's decisions and after the accounting (income and expenses). Costs for a forestry management contract depend on the services agreed on in the contract.
